Request for Qualifications – Addendum to 2023 Procurement for Professional Engineering Services

Statements of Qualifications (SOQs) will be received by Gates County Administrative Offices at the 1836 Historic Courthouse, 115 Court Street, Gatesville, NC 27928 until 2:00 p.m. September 16, 2024. Late submittals will not be accepted. Responding firms are not required to submit price information nor work product with submittal documents. Compliance with N.C.G.S. 143-64.31 is required.

Gates County is soliciting Statement of Qualifications from qualified firms interested in providing Civil Engineering services on an individual project basis for capital projects including, but not limited to, those identified in the Gates County Water and Wastewater Capital Improvement Plan, subsequent amendments or updates to the CIP, operational analysis and engineering studies for current and future water and wastewater long range planning, project development and construction administration, and on-call engineering services for any county departments. Gates County reserves the right to negotiate with one or more parties and is not obligated to enter into any contract with any respondents on any terms or conditions. Gates County reserves the right to seek professional services through a separate RFQ for any project, whether identified or unidentified within the CIP documents at its sole discretion. The selected firm(s) shall provide work on an as-needed basis upon assignment, by way of task order by the County.

Firms with significant relevant civil engineering experience and qualifications as described above are encouraged to submit a response to the RFQ. The purpose of the RFQ is to identify the most qualified respondents. Responding firms are not required to submit project specific scope information or pricing.

The Statement of Qualifications shall include a cover letter, description of firm's relevant & specialized experience, proposed project team members, project management & quality control, project approach & methodology, history of similar projects, and firm's reputation including lawsuits or claims filed against in the last five years.
