

## **Gates County Board of Commissioners Regular Meeting Minutes December 1, 2008**

The Gates County Board of Commissioners met in Regular Session on Monday, December 1, 2008 at 10:00 a.m. in the Commissioners' Room, 202 Court Street, Gatesville, NC. Commissioners Jernigan, Askew, Nickens and Twine were present. Also present was County Manager, Toby Chappell.

Commissioner Jernigan called the meeting to order. A prayer was conducted by Rev. Gene Asbill. The pledge of allegiance was led by Commissioner Jernigan.

Nell Wiggins, Clerk of Superior Court, came forward to swear in Henry Jordan, Carlton Nickens and Graham Twine.

Commissioner Jernigan asked for nominations for Chairman to the Board.

Commissioner Nickens nominated Commissioner Jordan to be Chairman to the Board. Commissioner Jordan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Commissioner Jernigan asked for nominations for Vice-Chairman of the Board.

Commissioner Twine made the motion to nominate Commissioner Jernigan to be Vice-Chairman to the Board. Commissioner Nickens seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

### **Approval of Minutes**

Commissioner Twine made a motion the minutes of the November 13, 2008 Commissioners' Meeting be accepted as written. Commissioner Askew seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Commissioner Nickens made a motion the minutes of the November 17, 2008 Commissioners' Meeting be accepted as written. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

### **Scheduled Appointments**

Reba Greene-Holley presented the Governor's 2008 Award for Outstanding Volunteer Service to Daniel and Laura Dickerson for their efforts regarding OLF.

Jerry Jennings, Division Engineer, NC Dept. of Transportation, presented the Secondary Roads Construction Program and gave an explanation of the 2008-09 anticipated allocation of funds. Mr. Jennings also requested a Resolution of support from the Commissioners

Commissioner Jernigan made a motion to accept the 2008-2009 NC Department of Transportation Secondary Roads Construction Program as presented by Mr. Jennings. Commissioner Nickens seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Gregg McGee, Board Chairman, Greater Albemarle Area Chapter of the Red Cross, stated the services provided cover an eight (8) county area. The local chapter is funded solely by public, private and corporate donations and contributions are down by \$35,000. The Red Cross' largest responsibility is to single-family home fires. Mr. McGee requested the Commissioners consider the needs of the Red Cross when working on next year's budget or if any funds become available this year.

Chairman Jordan stated consideration would be given in next year's budget.

Randall Cahoon, Director of Planning and Development Services, presented a Planning Board request for a Public Hearing on January 12, 2008 to amend the Subdivision Ordinance as recommended by special legal counsel, Travis Ellis.

Commissioner Nickens stated he would like to review the written text by Mr. Ellis.

Commissioner Twine requested to review the ordinance with the actual text corrections in place.

Commissioner Twine made a motion to have a Public Hearing to amend the Subdivision Ordinance text on January 12, 2008. Commissioner Nickens seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Mr. Cahoon presented a Planning Board request for a Public Hearing on January 12, 2009 for a text amendment to the current table of permitted uses to add fire stations, law enforcement and emergency services agencies.

Commissioner Twine made a motion to have a Public Hearing on January 12, 2009 for a text amendment to the current table of permitted uses to: Option A: add fire stations, law enforcement and emergency services agencies or Option B: to have locations zoned as R-1 and RMH-1 to allow fire stations, law enforcement and emergency services agencies with a special use permit, to be reviewed on an individual needs basis. Commissioner Nickens seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Mr. Cahoon presented a consistency statement regarding the four zoning actions taken presented at the November 17, 2008 meeting. NCGS 135a-342(b) requires units of government engaged in “small scale rezoning” to prepare and adopt a “statement analyzing the reasonableness of proposed rezoning” action

Commissioner Twine made a motion to table the consistency statement until the next scheduled meeting on January 5, 2009. Commissioner Nickens seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Mr. Cahoon presented a Planning Board request to submit a sample of the new zoning classifications to the Board. The Planning Board requested the Commissioners’ feedback on the new classifications before proceeding further with classification changes. He also presented a Planning Board request to have a facilitated joint workshop/planning session between the Planning Board, Commissioners and Board of Adjustment to coordinate planning efforts regarding amending the Zoning Ordinance to include new Zoning Districts, and to coordinate other planning efforts deemed necessary by the three boards.

Chairman Jordan stated for the Commissioners to meet with these two boards it would have to be an advertized meeting. He preferred these boards continue to meet independently and contact a Commissioner or come to the Board if they have questions.

Commissioner Twine stated proposed new businesses could come before the Board to request a special use permit as in the past.

Joe Greene, Planning Board member, stated he felt the Planning Board was not getting any direction from the Commissioners.

### **Old Business**

Toby Chappell, County Manager, presented the Proposed 2009 Holiday Schedule.

Commissioner Nickens made a motion to accept the Proposed 2009 Holiday Schedule. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

New Business

Mr. Chappell presented a Resolution authorizing the County Manager, Finance Officer, Commissioner Nickens and Commissioner Twine as the individuals to sign the Request for Funds for the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Scattered Site Housing (SSH) Grant awarded by the NC Department of Commerce, Division of Community Assistance.

Commissioner Twine made a motion to adopt the Resolution authorizing the County Manager, Finance Officer, Commissioner Nickens and Commissioner Twine as the individuals to sign the Request for Funds for the CDBG Grant. Commissioner Askew seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

The Resolution reads as follows:

**RESOLUTION**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE FOLLOWING AS THE INDIVIDUALS TO SIGN THE REQUISITION FOR FUNDS FOR THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) SCATTERED SITE HOUSING (SSH) GRANT AWARDED BY THE NORTH CAROLINA DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE, DIVISION OF COMMUNITY ASSISTANCE: COUNTY MANAGER; FINANCE OFFICER; COMMISSIONER GRAHAM TWINE OR COMMISSIONER CARLTON NICKENS.**

**WHEREAS**, the County of Gates has been awarded a grant in the amount of \$400,000 to be used for implementing the Scattered Site Housing Grant; and

**WHEREAS**, under the North Carolina Department of Commerce, Division of Community Assistance, a maximum of four (4) or a minimum of two (2) signatures are required on each requisition form, and

**WHEREAS**, in order to request funds, an authorized signature card must be completed.

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, effective December 1, 2008, the following individuals are hereby authorized to sign a Requisition for CDBG Funds: County Manager; Finance Officer; Commissioner Graham Twine or Commissioner Carlton Nickens.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Chairman to the Gates County Board of Commissioners is hereby authorized to be the Certifying Official on the Signatory Form and Certification.

Mr. Chappell presented the three bids received for the Hurricane Isabel Stream Debris Removal Project. They were: Larry Layne \$5,130.00, David Layne \$3,990.00 and J & J Construction and Environmental \$3,798.00, with a request to accept the bid from J & J Construction and Environmental.

Commissioner Twine made a motion to accept the bid from J & J Construction and Environmental for the Hurricane Isabel Stream Debris Removal Project. Commissioner Askew seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition. Mr. Chappell discussed a plan to move funds from Southern Bank to North Carolina Capital Management Trust (NCCMT) due to the interest rate being greater with NCCMT.

Chairman Jordan stated the Board needed a Cash Management and Investment Policy before proceeding with the transfer of funds for investment. He proposed to have a meeting at 9:00 a.m. on December 8, 2008 to work on a policy.

Commissioner Nickens made a motion to have a Special Meeting at 9:00 a.m. on December 8, 2008 to work on a Cash Management and Investment Policy. Commissioner Twine seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Sandy Pittman, Finance Officer, presented Budget Amendments 25 – 27.

Commissioner Twine made a motion to accept Budget Amendments 25 – 27 as presented. Commissioner Askew seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Commissioner Twine made a motion to give the County Manager the authority to have the necessary work performed on the Extension Building. He is also to check on the price of having the building restored historically versus making the necessary repairs. Commissioner Nickens seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Timmy Hedgepeth, Water Department Supervisor, presented a proposal to increase the water meter reconnect fee from \$15 to \$40.

Chairman Jordan stated the Board needs to know the cost of locking out a water meter and the number of lock outs performed a month to show the total expense to the Water Department. This information needs to be presented at the January 5, 2009 Commissioners' Meeting.

Chairman Jordan read a letter from Colleen Turner, Director of Social Services, to Chairman Jordan requesting his support in advising the Housing Committee's Board with ongoing work to help the citizens of Gates County living in substandard housing. To enhance the Housing Committee's efforts to coordinate donated funds, they are requesting expense and revenue lines in the DSS/County budget to enhance their ability to provide their services in a timely manner. The funds would be deposited in the County's General Fund.

Commissioner Twine questioned who was going to be responsible for approving invoices to be paid.

It was stated Colleen Turner, Director of Social Services would be responsible for approving the invoices to be paid for the Housing Committee.

Chairman Jordan presented a Resolution to Establish a Gates County Housing Committee Budget.

Commissioner Twine had a concern about a specific line in the proposed Resolution: "however, if deemed appropriate and seemly for the citizens of Gates County in the future, the Gates County Board of Commissioners may budget for and appropriate county funds for the "Housing Committee" as authorized by North Carolina General Statute 153A-255."

Commissioner Twine made a motion to remove the above referenced line from the proposed Resolution. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion. Commissioners Twine, Jernigan and Askew voted for the motion; Commissioner Nickens did not vote for the motion. Motion carried by a majority vote.

Commissioner Twine made a motion to adopt the proposed Resolution to Establish a Gates County Housing Committee Budget. Commissioner Jernigan seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

The Resolution to Establish a Gates County Housing Committee Budget reads as follows:

**RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH A GATES COUNTY HOUSING COMMITTEE  
BUDGET**

**SUBMITTED BY:** Gates County Board of Commissioners  
December 1, 2008

WHEREAS, Gates County has numerous citizens living in substandard housing conditions that affect their health, safety, and welfare; and the health, safety, and welfare of public servants visiting their property on official business; and

WHEREAS, the Gates County Department of Social Services has identified and continues to identify numerous citizens living in substandard housing conditions during the course of providing social service assistance to the elderly, disabled, and needy citizens; and

WHEREAS, the elderly, disabled, and needy families are not normally physically or financially able to repair or replace their homes; and

WHEREAS, the Gates County Board of Commissioners were informed of the substandard housing conditions that elderly, disabled, and needy citizens live in, and subsequently authorized the Gates County Department of Social Services to form a committee to help resolve the problem in accordance with North Carolina General Statute 153A-376; and

WHEREAS, the Gates County Department of Social Services has successfully formed a housing committee and established a partnership with the Gates County faith community and various local and state agencies that provide volunteer labor, financial resources, and services needed to repair or replace substandard housing for the elderly, disabled, and needy citizens of Gates County; therefore be it

RESOLVED, that the request of the Gates County Department of Social Services to amend the DSS/County budget to include an expense and revenue line for the "Housing Committee" be granted, as authorized by North Carolina General Statute 159-15; in order to manage donations and disperse funds as needed for project completions in a timely manner; and be it further

RESOLVED, that funding to support the efforts of the Gates County "Housing Committee" will be through donations received from citizens, businesses, and the faith community; no county funds are authorized by this resolution at this time; and be it further

RESOLVED, that in order to help obtain the lowest negotiated price for needed items, such as paint, etc., to complete repairs performed through the Gates Housing Committee, DSS may utilize contract pricing currently available to them through the State in accordance with the provisions of North Carolina General Statute 153A-449.

Chairman Jordan presented the Budget Amendment for the Gates County Housing Committee.

Commissioner Nickens made a motion to adopt the Budget Amendment as presented. Commissioner Twine seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.

Commissioner Twine requested a list of Housing Committee members so they could be appointed by the Board.

Commissioner Twine made a motion to accept the Housing Committee members upon notification by Colleen Turner. There was no second to the motion. The motion did not pass.

Reba Greene-Holley presented information from the public housing forum held on September 23, 2008. The objectives of the forum were to obtain community input as it relates to housing issues in the county and to inform Senator Ed Jones of these issues and share them with stakeholders and the public.

#### Additional Citizen Comments

Anne Askew stated Commissioner Askew was making a motion and Commissioner Nickens talked over him. She felt it was disrespectful.

Commissioner Nickens stated he was not aware he had talked over Commissioner Askew.

Chairman Jordan stated the Vice-Chairman at that time was to maintain order and control.

Mrs. Askew asked Chairman Jordan if had been to the School of County Government.

Chairman Jordan responded no. He has invested in a local government manual and studied it prior to taking the position. He has studied conducting of procedures. He felt his resume qualified him for the position.

Commissioner Nickens stated there are no specific criteria for being Chairman.

Commissioner Twine made a motion the meeting adjourn. Commissioner Nickens seconded the motion, motion carried without opposition.
