Voter Photo ID Requirement

All voters will be asked to show photo ID when voting in North Carolina. Most voters will simply show their driver's license, but there are many other acceptable photo IDs. For more info, go to [BringItNC.gov](https://www.bringitnc.gov).

Many types of photo IDs are **approved for voting** purposes. They include:

- NC driver's license or state ID from the NCDMV
- Driver's license or non-operator card from another state
- U.S. Passport book or U.S. Passport card
- NC voter photo ID card
- Approved Student & government-employee photo IDs
